The title search found that the two parcels were already legally separate parcels with separate deeds recorded, and that the error was in the tax map. Title report received from TD Bank. TD Bank's legal team reviewed Title Search with Town's Assessor, Arek Gordon, who stated that the County would correct the tax map. Per TD Bank, the Assessor requested that TD Bank obtain a "letter of non-jurisdiction" from the Planning Board before advancing the issue to the County.
